If taking public transportation:

Starting at Washington Marriot at Metro Center, 775 12th St NW

- Walk for 5 min to the Metro station called "Metro Center," located on the corner of G Street and 12th Street
- Take the **Red Line train** to "Shady Grove"
- Get off at the "Tenleytown/AU" station
- Cross the street and board the **Red Express Shuttle** to AU at Albemarle and 40th St. NW
- Ride for 4 stops and depart at the Katzen Arts Center



• Cross the street to main campus at 4400 Massachusetts Ave NW
